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Assessment Recognized in Faculty Annual Review

Updated in 2018, the faculty manual now provides a mechanism to recognize faculty participation in assessment in the annual review process as part of **Teaching** or **Service**, depending on the activity. This update aligns with the university's new EPPM policies on assessment, which include recognizing assessment work in annual review at all levels.
