Fall Welcome & ATL's Assessment Reporting Process

As the fall semester moves into full swing, we wanted to give you a peek into our own annual assessment reporting cycle.

Over the summer, we review data from the undergraduate assessment reports submitted by programs each June and produce summaries for WSU, college, and campus leadership, as well as for our university-wide archives that provide evidence of assessment activities in support of university accreditation. Annual WSU-wide summaries of undergraduate program assessment reports are published on the ATL website, typically each October—keep an eye out for an announcement in a future ATL Assessment Digest.

Each fall, as we meet with leadership across the university to discuss assessment priorities in each area, we address how to better support your work at the program level. ATL's aim is to support undergraduate program assessment at all levels of the university, creating a system in which we can work together to support meaningful undergraduate learning experiences at WSU.
