NEW Tableau Dashboard Summaries of 2023 Undergraduate Degree Program Assessment Reports Available

Each summer, we review data from the undergraduate assessment reports submitted by programs and produce summaries for the institution, as well as for our university-wide archives that provide evidence of assessment activities in support of university accreditation. New this year, we are providing 2023 annual undergraduate program assessment reporting summary dashboards for the university using Tableau, including a [WSU-wide and College View](#) and an [Individual Program View](#), available to WSU employees (log-in required). A WSU-wide executive summary for 2023, intended to summarize the university-wide data presented in the Tableau dashboards, is also available for the broader WSU community, as well as the public. 2023 Examples of Use of Program Assessment to Inform Decision-Making at WSU

WSU expects undergraduate degree programs to regularly use assessment to support decision-making related to curriculum, instruction, assignments, and program assessment processes. Each year, we compile [selected examples of how WSU programs in various disciplines have used assessment to inform decisions](#), as reported in the annual undergraduate degree program assessment reports. The examples, like the annual program reports themselves, look at key or representative activities and uses, and are not intended to be exhaustive or show all uses of assessment results by WSU programs.

	19 th	First day of instruction for the term.
Sept	17 th	Deadline for undergraduate students to drop a course without record.
	Late Sept	Fall 2024 [CAPS] instructors receive an email from UCORE with initial information about [CAPS] Assessment Reporting for UCORE for the fall term.
Oct	1 st	Fall submission deadline for major Curricular Change Requests for new and revised courses & new and revised requirements.
Nov	1 st	Program assessment coordinators receive an email from ACE with information about 2024 Undergraduate Program Assessment Reporting , including the report planning sheet. ACE is also available to help assessment coordinators complete the report; contact us for additional information.
	5 th	Fall 2024 WSU Celebration of Assessment Excellence at 3pm in the CUB Junior Ballroom (Zoom option available). Kindly RSVP by Nov 1st .
	15 th	Deadline for undergraduate students to withdraw from a course.
Dec	Early Dec	Fall 2024 [CAPS] instructors receive their link to the [CAPS] Assessment Reporting for UCORE form in Qualtrics via email (i.e., reporting opens).
	6 th	Last day of instruction for the term.
	Mid Dec	Program assessment coordinators receive an email from ACE with a unique link to their 2024 Undergraduate Program Assessment Reporting form in Qualtrics. Assessment coordinators can submit their report during the open reporting window — anytime from mid-Dec 2024 through Feb 2025.
	17 th	Final grade submission ends.
Jan	3 rd	Fall 2024 [CAPS] Assessment Reports for UCORE are due (i.e., reporting closes).
